THE DANISH UK CHAMBER OF COMMERCE ADVISORY BOARD

The role of the Advisory Board is to provide guidance to the Council of the Danish-UK Chamber of Commerce on its overall strategy and organisation. The Council of the Chamber likes to draw on the collective experience, insights and vision of our corporate members, allowing us to position ourselves for the challenges of the future, and help provide a higher level of support and benefits to our members.

The key roles of the Advisory Board are to:

- Provide advice on the strategy of the Chamber
- Facilitate closer cooperation within the Anglo Danish business community and with the Royal Danish Embassy
- Provide financial support to the Chamber (the fee for Advisory Board Membership is £3,000 per annum plus VAT)

The Advisory Board consists of the Chairmen or the MD of member organisations who may join the board. The board is chaired by the Chairman of the DUCC.

Among the benefits for Members of the Advisory Board are:

- Exclusive access to a network of Chairmen and MDs of the largest Chamber members
- The opportunity to attend the annual AB Dinner at the Residence of His Excellency the Danish Ambassador, as well as VIP status at Chamber events, with special introductions or private meetings with speakers, Ministers, dignitaries etc.
- Extensive opportunities for marketing and promotion within the sphere of the Chamber
- Includes Large Corporate membership of the Chamber
- Opportunity to host a Chamber event

The Advisory Board meet annually for a dinner at the residence of His Excellency the Danish Ambassador for a strategic discussion on the future direction of the Chamber. A further Annual event will be held for Advisory Board Members.

Who is on the Advisory Board?

Membership of the Advisory Board is by invitation only at the discretion of the Council of the Chamber. It is the intention that the board consists of the Chairmen and MDs of the largest companies involved in Anglo Danish business, however representatives who are deemed to possess unique qualities or insights may also be invited to attend, either on a permanent or ad hoc basis. Suggestions from the Advisory Board for membership are naturally encouraged and welcomed. The Advisory will have no more than 25 permanent members.

When all 25 appointments are made, members will have the opportunity to join the Advisory Board when a position becomes vacant.

Advisory Board Members commit themselves for periods of one year. Should a member wish to resign with effect from the following calendar year written notice must be given to the chamber before the 1st of October.
